

## **Required Immunizations for Rhode Island Students**

Requirements for entry

DTaP	Diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis	5
Hepatitis B	Hepatitis B	3
HPV	Human papilloma virus	1*
Meningococcal conjugate	Meningitis	1
MMR	Measles, mumps, rubella	2
Polio	Polio	4
Tdap	Tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis	1
Varicella	Varicella (chickenpox)	2**

12 <sup>th</sup> grade – requirements for entry AND all of the above

Meningococcal conjugate	Meningitis	1 (booster dose)	

## \*\*\* A current physical exam is required for all rising 12<sup>th</sup> grade students. \*\*\*

All CNA students must have a <u>2 step PPD test</u> (tuberculosis screening) done prior to enrollment in the CNA course. Try to have this done over the summer.

## <u>Flu vaccine</u> is mandatory for all CNA students and all students with an internship. Flu vaccine is offered in the fall at RINI. Consent forms will be sent home in September.

## **Recommended immunizations**

• Hepatitis A: All children should be vaccinated against hepatitis A when they are 1 year old.

<sup>\*\*</sup> A signed note by a health care provider stating that the child has had a history of chicken pox can meet the requirement for varicella immunizations.
