



RINI Policy - Transfer Credits

Rhode Island Nurses Institute Middle College Charter School accepts transfer credits from accredited school districts as long as the grade is an equivalent of a 70/C- or higher. Unless the credit was recorded as “earned” with a C- or better at the previous school, or unless a full semester was completed, no credit will be awarded. Not every course transferred to RINI will count towards the necessary requirements to graduate but will count towards the credits earned. The Director of Teaching & Learning, in collaboration with the school support counselors, will make every effort to align courses from outside districts to the prescribed scope and sequence of courses offered at RINI. All transfer credits will be included in the calculation of the overall GPA.

If a student has a transfer credit grade between a 60 - 69 for a course that RINI also offers (ex. Algebra I, ELA 10), the student can take the RINI final exam for that course to determine proficiency. If the student successfully scores a 70 or above, RINI will award that grade and accept the transfer credit.

To be eligible for transfer, credits must be from accredited middle and high schools, and documentation such as report cards/transcripts, course descriptions, and/or syllabi must be provided.
